Divisions & Events: Individual, Doubles, Relay, & Parent/Child

Stackers of any age & ability are eligible. Special Stackers (have a disability) will compete in the same events but separate divisions.

Finals: Top 10 **Awards:** Top 10 in Individual Top 5 in Doubles & Relay

Three Individual Events:

3x3x3 3x6x3 Cycle

Each Participant will have 2 practice tries, then 3 attempts per event, with their *best time being recorded.

*best time: the fastest of the 3 attempts after the 2 practices

Doubles:

Two stackers partner up and perform the "Cycle" with one stacker using their left hand while the other uses their right hand.

As with the Individual events, each double team will have 3 attempts with their Best time being recorded.

No one is allowed to be on more than one doubles team.

Relay:

Stackers team up in groups of 4 or 5. In this competition teams will not receive any practice attempts.

Teams of 4 stackers will take turns up stacking and down stacking the cups in a 3x6x3.

Each team will have 3 attempts with their best time being recorded. If a team has 5 stackers, it is up to them
to substitute from attempt to attempt. No one is allowed to be on more than one relay team.

Parent/Child:

In this event, a child can team up with their Parent/Guardian. As in the doubles, one stacker uses their left hand while
the other uses their right. In this event, the two stackers can choose which of the 3 individual stacks they prefer. For example,
if they prefer the 3x3x3 then they'll begin with 2 practice attempts, then move on to their next 3 attempts.

Regardless the event: 3x3x3, 3x6x3 or the Cycle the same procedure will apply.

For those looking to set a Sanctioned "Record" - The **Cycle** is required.
